Application Instructions*

- 1. Read all instructions and follow all directions completely. <u>Incomplete applications will not be considered.</u>
- 2. Applications must be typed or printed clearly and must be completed by the applicant.
- 3. All applications must include two (2) sealed letters of recommendation. At least one (1) of these letters must be from a teacher or a person in a position to evaluate your academic performance and ability.
- 4. Include a transcript of your most recent high school or college grades, with cumulative GPA, if any, visible. Self-generated grade printouts or class schedules will not be accepted as a substitute for a transcript.
- 5. If you are graduating high school in the Spring of 2024, or you are otherwise attending a college or university in which you are not currently enrolled, include a letter of acceptance from the college or university you plan to attend in the Fall of 2024.
- 6. Attach a personal statement of no more than 500 words on one of the topics provided on page 5 of the application.
- 7. Do not print 2-sided copies.
- 8. Do not use staples on any pages.
- 9. Do not include the instruction pages (pages 1 and 2) with your application submission.
- 10. Retain a copy of the completed application for your records.

Eligibility Requirements

- 1. Children, grandchildren, and spouses of United Association members who are in good standing with the UA are eligible, as long as they are dependent upon that UA member's financial support and maintenance. United Association members in good standing are also eligible.
- 2. You must plan to pursue or be pursuing post-high school education at an institution of higher learning.
- 3. You must have been accepted for admission or be enrolled in an accredited college or university at the time of the award.
- 4. You must not be a relative of anyone who is a Selection Committee Member or a Trustee of the United Association Scholarship Trust Fund.
- 5. You must be a full-time student and awards must be used for tuition or other education related expenses for the 2024-2025 school year.
- 6. Applications must be postmarked by June 12, 2024. Please be sure to include proper postage.

Award Criteria

Awards will primarily be based on academic achievement and potential, personal achievement, and community involvement. Scholarships will be awarded without regard to race, color, religion, sex or national origin. Applications will be judged by an independent and impartial Selection Committee, comprised of distinguished members of the community. Financial need may also be considered in making awards. The Selection Committee may request information concerning the financial circumstances of applicants and use this information in the award of scholarships. Finally, because UA scholarships do not automatically renew each year, receiving an award in one year does not guarantee you awards in future years.

In addition, six scholarships will be given to six "Second Chance" applicants. Those selected will be students whose academic achievement is not the best in their region, but rather students who demonstrate that they want another chance at an education at an institution of higher learning.

Awards should be announced by the end of July 2024. A list of winners will be posted on www.uanet.org, which is accessible by UA members. All applicants who submit paper applications by mail will be notified by mail of final results.

Children, grandchildren, and spouses of deceased UA members are also eligible if the child, grandchild, or spouse was dependent upon that UA member's financial support and maintenance prior to their passing.

¹ "Child" is defined as any unmarried natural or adopted child of a UA member who is dependent upon that UA member's financial support and maintenance.

[&]quot;Grandchild" is defined as any unmarried natural or adopted grandchild of a UA member, in good standing, who is dependent upon that UA member's financial support and maintenance and who has a regular parent-child relationship with that UA member.

[&]quot;Spouse" is defined as any spouse of UA member, in good standing, who is dependent upon that UA member's financial support and maintenance and who has a regular spousal relationship with that UA member.
