First Aid/CPR Course: Three (3) nights to complete from 5:30 PM to 8:30 PM.

Class size limited to 10 students.

The First Aid portion includes procedures for emergency moving of the injured, wounds/bleeding, traumatic shock, fractures, burns, eye injuries, temperature related problems and other job related emergencies. Adult CPR includes cardiopulmonary resuscitation, automatic external defibrillation.

Liquid Pipeline General Abnormal Operating Conditions for DOT Sites:

Class size is limited to 15 students.

Local Unions 9, 322 & 420 have come to see that tank farms & oil yards within their jurisdictions fall under Department of Transportation (DOT) requirements for craft works. 40 hour Basic Valve Repair Technician Course – In addition to classroom training, all hands-on labs are required to be completed by each trainee. The labs include practical exercises related to valve packing, fasteners and torqueing, precision measuring, gate valves, globe valves and butterfly, ball & plug valves.

32 Hour Advanced Valve Repair Technician Course - Was established based on industry's need for improved. Training of valve technicians in fields such as AOVs (Air Operated Valves), Pressure Seal Valves, Precision measuring, and hydraulic torqueing and tightening. Individuals must hold current credentials as a UA/EPRI Certified Valve Technician prior to applying for the Advanced Valve Technician training course.
