KEY ACCOMPLISHMENTS

- 83414 Promotes workforce diversity in public works projects; revises "public works projects" definition to permit project labor agreements for more projects.
- \$3810 "Responsible Collective Negotiations Act."
- "Building Our Future Bond Act"; authorizes the issuance of \$750,000,000 in general obligation bonds to finance higher educational capital projects for increasing of academic capacity.
- Establishes <u>new public-private partnership agreement option</u> for construction of State and county college facilities and changes reference from "Commission on Higher Education" to "Secretary of Higher Education" in higher education construction Educational Facilities Authority bond programs.
- S2737 Permits contractor in certain construction contracts with State college to choose between a retainage deduction from monthly progress payments or depositing a bond; allows 2% retainage deduction of amount due on each partial payment.
- \$2884 Appropriates \$715,706,303 from the "Building Our Future Bond Act" to the Office of the Secretary of Higher Education for public and private institutions of higher education.
- A3372 Concerns prevailing wage in construction projects connected with Board of Public Utilities financial assistance.
- \$2247 Requires Business Employment Incentive Program and other program grant recipients to pay the prevailing wage on certain public work projects.
- A1819 Extends prevailing wage requirements to projects of county improvement authorities, the CRDA, the Educational Facilities Financing Authority, and the Health Care Facilities Financing Authority.
- A1820 Concerns "card check" method of union recognition.
- A2049 Increases the amount of bonds issued for county college capital projects which qualify for State debt service aid support.
- A4161 Establishes prevailing wage standards for State building service contracts.
- A4563 Appropriates \$30,000,000 to the DEP from the "Wastewater Treatment Bond Act of 1985" for grants to or on behalf of local government units for wastewater treatment system projects.
- A1926 Concerns public works contracts and project labor agreements with labor organizations.
 - A13 Establishes "New Jersey Debt Defeasance and Prevention Fund," appropriates \$3.7 billion.
- A5889 Provides project grants under "Securing Our Children's Fund" for career and technical education expansion in county vocational school districts; appropriates \$222,904,769.
- S972 Concerns skilled and trained workforce in work by contractors in certain industries.
- \$1053 Establishes waterfront wage standards.
- \$2728 Adds two members to State Board of Examiners of Heating, Ventilating, Air Conditioning and Refrigeration (HVACR) Contractors.
- \$3995 Establishes School and Small Business Energy Efficiency Stimulus Program Fund in BPU.
- \$4207 Concerns apprenticeship programs of public works contractors.
- A3704 Clarifies training requirements of certain HVACR contractors.
- A5801 Concerns responsibility of contractors for wage claims against subcontractors.
- S865 Permits <u>public-private partnership agreements</u> for certain building and highway infrastructure projects; provides for EDA oversight.
- \$876 Revises process for development and administration of Transportation Trust Fund projects and capital program oversight; establishes transportation research center.
- \$1217 Requires BPU consideration and approval of amended application for qualified wind energy project offshore in certain NJ territorial waters.

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- \$2834 The "Water Quality Accountability Act"; imposes certain testing, reporting, management, and infrastructure investment requirements on water purveyors.
- \$2868 Increases value of Economic Redevelopment and Growth Grant program residential tax credits to \$823 million; restricts \$105 million of tax credits to qualified residential projects and mixed use parking projects.
- \$612 Provides for licensure of elevator, escalator, and moving walkway mechanics by State board.
- \$1027 Extends for 18 months application submission deadline to EDA for review and approval of certain construction projects involving public institutions of higher education.
- S1925 Revises certain solar renewable energy programs and requirements; provides for aggregated net metering of electricity consumption related to properties owned by certain governmental bodies and school districts.
- \$2363 Requires home improvement contractors to display State-issued identification badge; requires surrender in certain circumstances; imposes penalty for improper display of badge.
- \$2539 Authorizes release or reduction of original performance guarantee after deposit of adequate replacement performance guarantee by successor developer.
- S920 Revises provisions of "New Jersey Economic Stimulus Act of 2009" concerning public-private higher education construction and improvement projects and municipal ordinances to adopt stimulus measures.
- S2036 The "Offshore Wind Economic Development Act"; establishes offshore wind renewable energy certificate program, and authorizes EDA to provide tax credits for qualified wind energy facilities in wind energy zones.
- \$2370 Revises financial assistance under Business Retention and Relocation Assistance Grant Program; repeals requirement to study implementation.
- A2867 The "Permit Extension Act of 2008."
- A2962 Establishes licensing program for site remediation professionals; changes laws concerning site remediation.
- A4268 Extends prevailing wage requirements to certain maintenance-related projects.
 - S241 Exempts certain renewable energy systems from real property taxation.
- \$2773 Concerns suspension and revocation of employer licenses for repeated violations of wage, benefit and tax laws.
- \$3092 Prohibits SDA from restricting the ability of certain firms or persons from competing for contracts in more than one Division of Property Management and Construction classification or pregualification category.
- A4009 Debars certain employers from public work and establishes criminal penalties for misclassification of construction workers as independent contractors.
- A4336 Establishes the New Jersey Schools Development Authority and revises the school construction program established under the "Educational Facilities Construction and Financing Act."
- A4559 Authorizes auction of greenhouse gas allowances; establishes "Global Warming Solutions Fund."
- Requires persons transacting business in this State and making payments to unregistered unincorporated construction contractors to withhold gross income taxes from those payments.
- \$1726 Concerns the prompt payment of construction contracts.
- A3542 Establishes the "School Construction Review Commission."
- S596 Applies prevailing wage to custom fabrication of woodwork and plumbing, heating, cooling and ventilation or exhaust duct systems.
- \$1368 Streamlines certain permitting in smart growth areas.
- \$1886 Enhances rights and remedies of employees who disclose or refuse to participate in fraudulent employer practices.
- \$2264 Permits unemployment benefits for workers "locked-out" by their employers.
- A2165 Revises process for governmental energy aggregation.

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
